Dear Parent / Carer

As well as excellent academic achievement, enrichment is a vital part of developing life-long skills in children. Now more than ever, developing a thriving enrichment programme is an essential part of promoting employability, academic attainment and teaching young people the skills they need to make good choices. These skills have benefits well beyond the classroom.

During enrichment week for 2019 on Monday we will have our annual Sports Day and students should wear PE kit. On Tuesday students will have a career focused "world of work" themed day. Wednesday will be our 'enrichment day' in which the booklet details the choices available for students. Thursday will be the tutor challenge day in which students will complete a series of challenges with their tutor teams.

With regards to the options for Wednesday 17th July, it is important to discuss the choices fully with your child as some have slightly different arrival times back to school and have a cost attached. At this stage the costings are approximate because it depends on the number of students who opt for the activities. It is important your child returns their slip to the office by **9th February**. By **20th March** students will find out their assigned option choices and full payment is due by **1st May**. If the reply slip is not returned on time or payment is not received by the due date, your child will be moved on to a cost free activity.

Additionally, students can opt to do a work experience placement. However, they must arrange this themselves and this will only be approved with the return of two forms which can be collected from the main office and completed by the lead person at the placement. This is a statutory requirement.
